This Course will introduce you to many different sites which you can use to create resources for your Library or classroom. All resources shown are provided in a handout to keep, with fantastic display suggestions, lesson icebreakers and motivating electronic ideas which you can use to really get your pupils switched on to learning and reading. Examples of how you can use these sites will be provided, and a follow up session for any queries will be arranged. Advice on how to use digital media and QR codes to enthuse your students will be given, to mention just a few practical 'takeaways' that you will get from this session.
